

In 2010, TSOANSW (Triumph Sports Owners' Association of New South Wales) will host the National Meeting. Accommodation for the event will be at the Kangaroo Valley Golf Resort in Kangaroo Valley, NSW.

The resort consists of 1, 2 and 3 bedroom studios, cabins and villas, all with spectacular views, and convenient parking. Accommodation will be allocated on a basis no-sharing of bathroom facilities i.e. each couple will have their own bathroom or en-suite, unless otherwise negotiated. All accommodation is fully self-contained, with well-equipped kitchens and many with timber decks. There is a dining area, entertainment area and bar on site. There are BBQ facilities within the grounds, or alternatively, portable BBQs for can be hired within the resort. Continental breakfasts will be provided. The accommodation is located around the golf course. The resort also has swimming pools, volleyball court, giant chess and tennis. Pamper packages can be arranged.

Kangaroo Valley is located in a tranquil valley about 2.5 hours from Sydney. It is situated west of Nowra in an area famous as dairy country but fast becoming a fine wine and food region. The area is close to the Southern Highlands with the historic garden towns of Berrima, Bowral and waterfalls. It is about 1.5 hour drive to Wakefield Park and 1 hour to Marulan for the competition events.

It is anticipated that the total cost for the National Meeting will be \$1000 and this will include the accommodation in a twin share room with your own bathroom or ensuite facilities. Single delegates may need to pay additional costs, or advise if they would be happy to be housed in a two bedroom/1 bathroom or three bedroom/2 bathroom villa. Participants will be supplied with continental breakfast for each day, five evening meals and most lunches.

Competition events will be covered in the tariff and the alternative event on the Monday will also be covered.

### Tentative Programme

Sat 11	Registration, Happy hour and welcome dinner at Kangaroo Valley Golf Resort
Sun 12	Concours and Show'n'Shine day at the Showground, Kangaroo Valley. The Showground is in the centre of the village of Kangaroo Valley with its pub, craft shops and galleries. Lunch will be provided at the venue by the local Lions Club. In the afternoon there will be time to explore local attractions. We recommend the Illawarra Fly Tree Top Walk about 30 minutes drive from the Valley. If heights are not your thing, visit Arthur Boyd's home "Bundanoon" (note dirt road) or Meroogal, in nearby Nowra. Dinner will be provided back at the Resort.
Mon 13	Competition Day at Wakefield Park, events will include SuperSprints, a Hill Climb and a 10 lap All Triumph Race. Lunch will be provided at the track. Those not wishing to be involved with the racing can enjoy a Coach trip around the southern highlands, taking in the historic towns of Berrima, Bowral (Bradman Oval) and the beautiful gardens of the highlands in spring, it's Tulip Time. Lunch will be provided for all participants. Dinner will be at the Kangaroo Valley Bowling Club. A shuttle bus will be provided to and from the resort, if required.
Tues 14	Touring Day with observation run taking in the scenery along the Grand Pacific Drive and the fabulous Sea Cliff Bridge. Lunch at a <i>Room with a View</i> . Own arrangements for dinner.
Wed 15	Competition Day at Marulan Driver Training Centre, a new track only opened in 2009. SuperSprints in the morning, with lunch provided at the track. In the afternoon, there will be an opportunity for all participants to have the experience of driving on a race track in a non-competitive atmosphere. Non-competitors can spend the morning exploring Goulburn with its historic brewery, churches and homes, and of course, the Big Merino. Scheduled State delegates meeting prior to dinner at the Resort.
Thurs 16	Touring Day, taking in the Naval Museum at HMAS Albatross near Nowra, wineries near Berry, Kiama and its Blow Holes and other local attractions. Own arrangements for dinner. You might like to buy fresh sea food from the wharf at Kiama.
Fri 17	Touring day or just 'vege' out. A tour will be arranged for those interested in visiting the Nan Tien Buddhist temple near Wollongong. Alternatively, take some time to enjoy the facilities at the resort – golf, tennis, swimming pool, volleyball. Alternatively there are many other attractions within a short drive, brochures will be provided. Presentation and farewell dinner at the Resort.
